Washington, D.C. this summer.

The E. Fleming Mason Memorial Internship Program was created to provide deserving undergraduates with the desire to become better educated and informed on both the public and private sectors of the national government with a unique experience. This program gives undergraduates the opportunity to gain professional work experience while living in the Washington, D.C. area. The E. Fleming Mason Memorial Internship

Program provides a once in a lifetime opportunity to any qualified Kappa Alpha Order undergraduate. The internship, living in Washington, D.C. and interacting with other interns from across the country, provides an everlasting experience.

The program, funded by the Kappa Alpha Order Educational Foundation, pairs undergraduates with internships in the nation's capital and provides travel, room and board at no cost to the participants. Humphreys interned at the American Business Development Group, a defense-focused consulting and lobbying firm in Arlington, Virginia. Nu Chapter is one of only two chapters in the Order to have had two members selected for the program in its six year history.

Humphreys stated, "This summer was an unbelievable experience. I learned so much and had a great time exploring D.C. as well. I will be forever grateful to KA for allowing me this opportunity."

With \$16,095 pledged by 102 generous donors, Nu Chapter has ended the two year *Nu Additions Campaign*. This successful campaign allowed several important projects to be completed at the Mansion including bricking the façade of the event barn, constructing a large deck, extending the usable space of the event barn and installing a large, granite sign facing the intersection of Wire Road & Lem Morrison Drive.
